Rules

1. Items must be baked (e.g. Apple Pie, cupcakes, cookies)
2. Entries must be homemade
3. No glass containers. Non-returnable plastic or aluminum preferable
4. Attach a card with ingredients to have on hand in case a judge has an allergy to ingredients
5. After judging, desserts will be shared with the campus community during the festival
6. Entries are to be delivered between 7:30 AM - 8:30 AM on Oct. 10, to Cone 313 to be considered for entry
7. REGISTER at stafforg.uncc/ events

Rules

1. Photos must be submitted in frame with kickstand and no larger than 8x10
2. Submission quantity is limited to the first 15 entries
3. One entry allowed per contestant
4. Photography must be your original work; not purchased or downloaded
5. Contestant must be an amateur not a photographer by trade, profession, or award
6. NO nudity or profanity photography permitted
7. Photographs must be picked up by 1:30pm the day of the festival
8. Entries are to be delivered between 7:30 AM - 8:30 AM on Oct. 10, to Cone 313 to be considered for entry
9. REGISTER at stafforg.uncc/ events

Rules

1. Item must be a homemade craft, not purchased or downloaded
2. Submission quantity is limited to the first 15 entries
3. NO nudity or profanity permitted
4. Entries are to be delivered between 7:30 AM - 8:30 AM on Oct. 10, to Cone 313 to be considered for entry
5. REGISTER at stafforg.uncc/ events

Rules

1. Team members' names (5 or less) must be submitted upon registration
2. Current photo entries are to be submitted with scavenger item and at least one team member in the image
3. Trivia Questions will be provided as necessary for tie breakers
